D. ARTIST STATEMENT

The artist statement should help the evaluator understand your art and the methods used to create it. The purpose is to increase the evaluator's interest and help them understand **why YOU should receive this scholarship**. The statement should be no less than 100 words and no more than 300 words. Include:

1. **A broad statement that tells us about what inspired you to be a visual or performance artist. For example:**
 - I began to write poetry to help express my feelings when my friend moved away.
 - I like clog dancing because my family is Irish.

2. **Your art related goals for the future. They may be specific goals or future "dreams". For example:**
 - Sing in a Broadway musical.
 - Become an art therapist.
 - Teach art to pre-schoolers.

3. **Identify the works included in the portfolio and, if possible, make comments.**

For example:

 - Included are videotapes of my singing a solo in the community school production of West Side Story.
 - Attached are photos of the furniture I built in woodworking class.

E. ART-RELATED ACTIVITIES AND AWARDS

List participation in **Art-Related** activities AND awards or special honors that you have received in school or the community. Include the approximate dates that you participated or when they were received.

For example:

- Art classes, teacher's assistant hours, performances, clubs, lessons or volunteer work. Include the approximate dates of participation.
- A school newspaper review talked about your performance in the high school musical.
- A drawing was accepted in the Community Art Show.

F. OTHER HONORS OR ACTIVITIES

List any other **NON-ART** related honors or activities that are important to you.

G. TEACHER'S RECOMMENDATION

Include **at least 2** recommendations from teachers who know you. Greater weight will be given to Art Teacher's recommendations.

H. EXAMPLES OF YOUR WORK

The "**EXAMPLES**" section in the portfolio is **your chance to STAND OUT FROM THE CROWD!** Provide **several examples** of your work and **label each clearly**. Make sure that the presentation is **neat** and **easy to follow**. How you present your work depends on whether the art is visual or performance art.

- If your art is visual, then photos are usually the best format. These may be collected in a scrapbook, in a folder, portfolio envelope, in a binder or on CD.
- If your art is performance art, please provide CD's, audiotapes or videotapes.

HINTS:

- There is no separate portfolio required. When all of the above information (A-H) is completed and packaged – this IS your portfolio.
- Read and follow directions carefully and make sure that your portfolio is **complete**. Incomplete portfolios will not be considered.
- To be eligible all **portfolios must be submitted** to your teacher or counselor

by no later than FRIDAY, APRIL 27, 2018 by 4 pm

- Your teacher or counselor will be a good resource to help develop your portfolio.
